Frequently asked questions - and answers.

Have you guys lost your minds? Mid-life crisis?

LOL! We haven't lost our minds, but it's become increasingly clear over the years that we want to dedicate our lives to growing God's Kingdom.

When do you leave?

We have a couple of target dates. In June, we'll attend the Center for Intercultural Training (CIT) in North Carolina for our pre-field training in cross-cultural ministry.

If our funding is in place, we'll move to Hungary later this year. It'll take us a few months to get acclimated, and meet the teams in Hungary and other countries in Eastern Europe. During this time we'll establish our objectives for the first year and begin our work. (There's already a whiteboard list of ideas - we just have to get there!) Our children, Chloe and Sarah, will attend school at the International Christian School of Budapest, an accredited school located in a suburb of Budapest.

How does raising financial support work?

Although it's not easy asking others for financial support, we strongly believe God calls us to invite others to invest in His ministry. It's not unlike supporting your own church. The pastor(s), staff, and building expenses are paid with the tithes and offerings from the congregation. Without their generous giving, the church would not exist.

So it is with missionaries, who typically develop relationships with churches and individuals interested in seeing God's Kingdom expanded

not just in the United States, but throughout the world.

We are humbled and privileged to be able to use the gifts and talents God has given us to reach people for Christ.

All contributions are sent to United World Mission (UWM) and earmarked for our account. UWM provides the financial accountability, and assists us administratively.

How much should I give?

There is no gift too small, and no gift too large! God wants a cheerful giver, so give the amount that blesses you, whether it's monthly, annually or a special gift. We are grateful for every contribution.

How does the process work?

All you need to do is send your contribution to United World Mission and indicate you want the funds directed to our ministry. UWM ensures the funds are distributed properly and in accordance with all appropriate rules and regulations.

Once you send your first check to UWM, the agency will provide envelopes to continue your contributions. If you prefer, UWM also offers electronic funds transfer (EFT), so you can set up a monthly gift to come automatically from your checking account. You also have the option of setting up a monthly charge to a credit card.

How long am I committing to supporting you?

Many people commit to a three-year term. At the end of that time, we encourage you to pray, then give as your heart leads you.

Of course, life happens. So if you experience a change in finances,

please know that you are not "locked in". You may change your giving at any time. Just let us know so we can set our budget appropriately.

Why Europe instead of the United States?

It's true that the United States is one of the largest mission fields in the world. But our great country also has some of the greatest resources available. Think about it. There's probably more than one church within an easy drive of your home. American pastors have incredible amounts of training materials at their disposal.

That's simply not true in many places, including Hungary. And that's where UWM comes in. UWM's mission is to serve with Christian leaders globally to plant, nourish and reproduce churches that delight God and surprise the world.

There are a lot of people interested in global missions who aren't able to go themselves. Instead, they're willing to invest a portion of their financial resources to people like us, who are prepared to make the leap of faith to serve overseas. We're willing to go!
